MCR 2024 1,000 point judging. I want to try and clear up or maybe muddy up the 1,000 point judging class that we are doing at MCR 2024.

All of the cars in this class will be judged and receive a trophy with a picture of their car on it and the amount of points they received. They do not compete against each other they are all judged on their own quality of work.

All of the judging in this class is based on quality of work not on originality unless the owner says it is an original restoration. There is a big difference between judging original and judging quality for any of the classes that the car might be in. Most of the cars that want judged are not original restorations but are very good quality restorations. To judge in this class what the judges are looking for is quality of workmanship. If you have any questions please ask.
