The MACC Car Show Committee has recommended to the membership that MACC no longer participate in hosting a Mid-West Chevelle Regional. This recommendation was not made lightly. However, based on participation from regional clubs at recent shows, the committee does not see sufficient value in continuing to host a regional event.

Recent Participation from the region

- 2023 Regional: 146 total attendees; 5 regional attendees.
- 2025 Regional: 140 total attendees; 5 regional attendees.

Annual All-Chevelle Show

MACC will continue to hold its annual all-Chevelle show, as it has for more than 30 years. All Chevells are welcome to attend. This change will also give MACC greater flexibility in how the show is planned and conducted.

Regional Club Participation

All regional clubs are welcome to attend MACC's annual event with no obligation to provide monetary support.

If another club in the region decides to hold a regional show, MACC will support the event by encouraging its members to attend. However, MACC will not provide monetary support at this time.
