## WACCC Quarterly Meeting Minutes, Tuesday, August 15, 2017

Spangles Restaurant, Kellogg and Broadway, Wichita

The Quarterly meeting of the Wichita Area Council of Car Clubs (hereinafter referred to as WACCC) met at Spangles Restaurant on August 15, 2017 beginning at 7:00PM. President Royce Taylor called the meeting to order and announced that in the absence of Secretary Rick Cain, Treasurer Rod Wake would be acting Secretary. Royce asked for a reading of the minutes.

Minutes of the May 2017 Meeting: Vice President Chris Pyle stated that we all received the minutes in the Newsletter and made a motion that the reading of the minutes be waived. This motion was seconded by Jim Petty. Royce Taylor stated that there was one error in the minutes as printed, that the minutes stated that \$200 was paid to Lake Afton for the facility, when the correct amount was \$250.00. With that correction the reading of the minutes was waived and a voice vote was taken, the minutes were accepted as printed in the newsletter.

Treasurer's Report: Rod Wake gave the Treasurer's report, by stating that at the May meeting the WACCC bank balance was \$3,546.80. Since that time the Lake Afton All Wheels Rally had been accomplished, several deposits and withdrawals had been made; the Insurance premium of \$350.00 has been paid and the Lake Afton accounts were

all settled. Royce Taylor has \$60 held out to assist in the sale or disposition of remaining T-Shirts but the bank balance shown on the July bank statement at this time is \$3,072.10. Treasurer Rod stated that he had just paid Kent Michael for Newsletter expenses. Royce Taylor also announced that Jim Petty had turned in \$3.00 he had received as contributions for Cruizin Calendars.

Daryl Standifer raised a question about the cost of the Port-a-Potties. This was discussed thoroughly with no change recommended for next year. Royce Taylor volunteered, however, to check into finding a more economical plan for next year.

Royce Taylor also stated that most of our inexpensive signs were ruined by the wind at this year's All Wheels Rally. Discussion was held about replacing the signs, the type of signage and materials, and Daryl Standifer asked for a list of what is needed for him to do some research. Joshua Blick stated that used Realtor Signs can be purchased from the City of Wichita at 1224 S. McLean. Taylor volunteered to look into purchase of sign material.

Old Business: The Lake Afton All Wheels Rally is over, it was hot and it was windy, and Royce Taylor said WACCC tent could not be erected because of the wind. Royce sold the balance of the C-10 shirts to the C-10 club. Some



non-food vendors did not show up (Non food vendors pay \$50 and food vendors pay \$175.00) which reduced expected revenue. The big issue, Taylor stated, is that we have 79 T-Shirts left over. We also have 49 dash plaques of which about \$1100 in proposed retail sales was not made. Treasurer Rod Wake stated that we went into the show with close to \$4,000 in the bank and after the show we have approximately \$3,000 left. Chris Pyle stated that he had a lot of help by the Thunderbird Club in making the sales. This allowed him to leave the sales booth from time to time, yet the shirts did not sell well. Complaints from the public were passed on about the T-Shirts and Daryl Standifer reminded all that this was supposed to be the Lake Afton T-Shirts, with the car club being secondary. The Lake Afton Show should be the title of the shirt, with the featured club being second. President Taylor continued that the main problem is that the Nuttin But Love club, the featured club this year, ordered their T-Shirts separately from our supply which leaves us with excess shirts unsold. Our proposed profit is all in the form of T-Shirts. Taylor stated that he had asked Nuttin But Love to buy the leftover shirts. So far no excess shirts have been sold. Taylor asked how the council proposed to sell the shirts? Retail or wholesale? Suggestion was made that we get at least our cost back for them. Daryl Standifer made suggestions about a different pricing plan for the future. Lake Afton will be held June 10 next year, 2018. Future dates are all published in the current Newsletter.

Taylor also stated that a big help this year came from the presence of Sheriff's Patrol vehicles which probably prevented "burn outs" and other mischief at the show. Visit Wichita has contacted Taylor about publicizing Lake Afton next year. Sponsors for Lake Afton 2018 are being solicited. Jim Petty reported that the Hudson Club had a convention recently and one event was that they allowed the Boy Scouts Pinewood Derby to be a part of the convention. In addition to the Pinewood Derby they offered an Ice Cream Social for \$10 each for all you could eat. It was well received at that event, and the Boy Scouts would be available for a future show or convention.

New Business: Joshua Blick, new owner of Automobilia car show attended this meeting. Blick stated that he appreciated the cooperation from the Car Council and has

hopes and plans for future shows. He will be glad to help the council in any way he can, and appreciates our help in Automobilia. Blick said the Automobilia show will now be 100% for charity. Cars for Kids, and similar charities will be the recipients; all will be given to local charities, not out of state.

Sunflower Swap Meet for 2018 will be held at Century II. Discussion was held about the feasibility of the Council having a booth or table set up at the swap meet. Discussion was held about having flyers printed. Similar discussion was held about the Starbird/Devlin Cars for Charities show but no separate booth or table was decided upon.

Elections for officers will be at the next meeting. Taylor asked which officers would be willing to serve again? He stated that he will be available; Wake said he would be available; Pyle said he would be available but Taylor stated that Cain is changing jobs and maybe moving.

A representative of the Mustang Club stated that the Erin is Hope Show was cancelled earlier this year due to street repairs, and the show will now be held on Friday, September 29, with all profits going to Erin is Hope.

Daryl Standifer stated that our ad for the Cruisin Calendar will cost \$800.00 with 10% discount (\$720.00) if paid before November 1, and presented an invoice for it. Chris Pyle made a motion to pay the bill today rather than pay closer to November 1. Taylor stated that we are here, and Cruisin Calendar's Standifer is here, and in his opinion we ought to pay now. The motion already made to pay now, was seconded by Jim Petty, a voice vote was held, the motion passed. Treasurer Wake wrote the check to C.A.R.S. for the Cruizin Calendar ad.

Next meeting will be Tuesday, November 21, 7:00 at Spangles. With no additional new business coming forth, Chris Pyle made the second and Jim Petty seconded, that the meeting be adjourned. The "ayes" had it and Taylor announced that the meeting was adjourned.
